





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 L_p values listed in the AISC *Manual* for shapes with noncompact flanges are adjusted to account for the noncompactness. If the shape has noncompact flanges, as many HP shapes do, then the value listed in Table 4-2 is L_p' as shown in AISC *Manual* Figure 3-1.
